Submitted papers will be peer-reviewed on the basis of technical quality, relevance, originality, significance and clarity. Selected papers will be published in ISBN volume of proceedings. IPMA WC2017 proceedings will be submitted for inclusion in the IEEE Xplore digital library, as well as other Abstracting and Indexing (A&I) databases (Web of Science, Scopus, Google Scholar and etc.).

Proposal for presentations, workshops and special sessions are also welcome.

Poster presentations will be peer-reviewed on the basis of technical quality and relevance. Posters will be A1 format and will attract a fee of €90 for the three days of the congress.
